Authors Guideline:

- 1) Manuscripts and editorial correspondence should be address to: maualirajan@gmail.com
- 2) All manuscripts should be typed on one side of A-4 paper with margins on all sides and on double spaced throughout.
- 3) The text should be in Times New Roman and the style of presentation should be (a) Title of the paper : Upper case, Font-12, Bold, Normal, Times New Roman, middle justified/ Authors title case, Font-11, Bold, Italic, Times New Roman, right justified. Authors affiliation, title case, font-11, Normal, Times New Roman.
- 4) All articles must include key words and an abstract of 150 words.
- 3) Follow the British spellings, in particular, use 's' in words ending with 'ise' and 'isation'.
- 4) Articles should be written in British English and should be 3000-5000 words in length. Article should be prepared and presented following the style mentioned below. The paper should be accompanied with a declaration to the effect that the paper is original work of the author(s) and the paper has not been submitted for publication cover page along with the title of the paper and should not be repeated anywhere else. The title of the paper should be followed by name, e-mail and affiliation of author(s).
- 5) Please provide two hard copies and an identical electronic copy as an e-mail attachment.
- 6) References: References appear at the end of the paper. They can be single spaced and not smaller than 10pt font size.
